Time	Logistics	Activity
0830	Arrive Saschiz at Pivnita Bunicii	Slow Food Tarnava Mare – brief introduction (with leaflet to take home) Tasting of jams with pancakes
0900-1000	Walk through village to church	Games organised by Marianne
1000-1100	Walk to pottery	Demonstration Signing pre made name plate
1100-1215	Walk to Pension Cartref via fountain	Visit the Cooking Museum with explanations about cooking tools in the past and self-sufficiency of the household in Saxon villages (it will be full of fun as we have some questions and contests about tools). Split into groups and compete in making rhubarb cake. While the cake is in the oven, children have a snack lunch (around 12.00) Take cakes out of the oven: taste and package one piece to take home
1215	Potter arrives at Cartref	Each child gets their cake and pottery items to take home
1230	Depart for home	

Estimated number of children 24 plus 9 teachers / parents / minders
